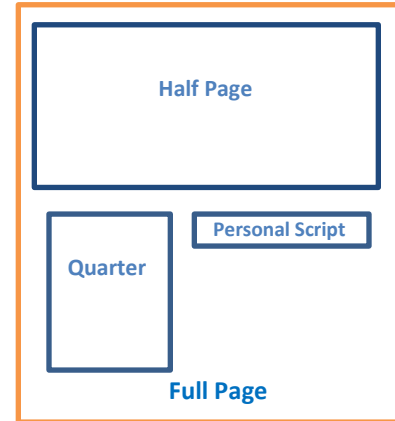

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING IMAGES, PHOTOS OR COMPANY LOGOS:

It is best to submit images/photos/logos in a digital, electronic format. If you have an electronic image, you can send it via email to gsc@goodshepherdnyc.com. Alternately, you may bring a hard copy of the photo/image or a CD of the files (saved at the highest size and quality available) to the rectory office at the address above. Please label all CDs and individual images clearly with your name, address, phone number and email address. Please enclose any hard-copy images you wish to be returned to you in an unsealed, padded or protected self-addressed envelope with the necessary postage so we can mail the photos back to you.

You can rest assured that your images will be handled with the utmost care. Nonetheless, mistakes can happen, and the parish can take no responsibilities for misplaced or damaged photos/images. If your photos are of special historical or personal value, please consider submitting a digital copy instead of the original print. In this case, photos should be scanned 600dpi and stored in TIFF format (these settings should be available in the software used to scan the image).
